In 1240, King of France “Saint Louis” decided to build a city close to his kingdom in order to have direct access to the Mediterranean Sea. The result was Aigues-Mortes, in an area of marshes, sand and water. Seven centuries later, the fortification still dominates the Camargue as one of France’s best preserved medieval buildings.
